



PROTECTION FRAMEWORK

EN ISO 20345: 2011 – Safety footwear used for general purposes. It includes, for example, mechanical risks, slip resistance, thermal risks, ergonomic behaviour.

EN ISO 20347: 2012 – Occupational footwear that is not exposed to any mechanical risks (impact or compression)

For professional use: **Fishing - agriculture - food industry - cleaning** or other activities requiring this kind of protection.

PERFORMANCE

EN ISO 20345 (S4+SRC+CI)

S4 = Basic safety requirements + antistatic footwear + energy absorption in the heel region of at least 20 J + toe cap

SRC = Slip resistance on ceramic tile wetted with dilute soap solution + slip resistance on steel floor with glycerol

CI = Cold insulation

PRINCIPAL MATERIALS

Polyurethane

Easy to clean and disinfect due to their extra smooth design

INSTRUCTIONS

- CARE
 - Clean the boots after every use with water and soap, using a soft brush
 - Rinse immediately
 - Allow to dry well
- STORAGE
 - Store the boots in a well-ventilated place

For maximum protection, check the condition of your boots thoroughly before each use.

DO NOT USE the boots if the protective parts (i.e. toe cap, sole) are damaged.
